Implementation Plan of Point-based Admission for Children of Migrant Workers in Haizhu District

Article 1 In order to further improve the compulsory education for the children of migrants in Guangzhou, this Implementation Plan (hereinafter referred to as the “Plan”) is formulated according to the *Compulsory Education Law of the People’s Republic of China*, *Regulations of Guangdong Province on the Administration of Migrant Population Services*, *Guidelines of the General Office of the People’s Government of Guangdong Province on Conducting Compulsory Education for Children of Migrant Workers* (Yue Fu Ban [2011] No.45), the *Notice of the People’s Government of Guangzhou Municipality on the Release of the Regulations on the Management of Point-based Service for Migrants in Guangzhou* (Sui Fu Gui [2021] No.7), the *Notice of Guangzhou Municipal Education Bureau on the Release of the Guidelines on the Implementation of Services for the Purchase of Admission Qualifications as Students of Privately-run Compulsory Education Schools in Guangzhou* (Shui Jiao Gui Zi [2022] No.1) and other laws and regulations and the themes of higher-level documents, on the basis of the actual conditions of Haizhu District and with a view to making overall arrangements for the children of migrant workers in Guangzhou to obtain the admission qualifications as first-year students in the public primary schools, the public junior high schools or the government-funded private schools in Haizhu District by means of point-based admission (hereinafter referred to as “Point-based Admission”).

Article 2 The term “migrant workers” herein refers to citizens of the People’s Republic of China who have non-local household registration, live in the administrative areas of Guangzhou Municipality, and hold a valid Residence Permit of Guangdong Province. This Plan is applicable to migrant workers who apply for the point-based admission in Haizhu District for their school-age children who move with them.

Haizhu District Education Bureau and Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau jointly formulate and publish the *Detailed Rules for the Implementation of the Point-based Admission in the Current Year* (hereinafter referred to as the “Detailed Rules”).

Article 3 The migrant workers apply for points on line through the “Point-based Service Management Information System for Migrant Workers in Guangzhou” based on the indicators listed in the *Point-based Service Management Index System and Score Table for Migrant Workers in Guangzhou*. The migrant workers apply for the point-based admission ranking in the current year for their children based on the points obtained for the approved point-based admission items listed in the “Point-based Service Management Information System for Migrant Workers in Guangzhou”. Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau puts the applicants’ points in order from high to low, and arranges admission qualifications based on the applicants’ intentions and the point-based admission plan of Haizhu District in the current year.

Article 4 The conditions for migrant workers to apply for point-based admission for their children who move with them: The applicant shall live legally and stably in Guangzhou City and hold a valid Guangdong Residence Permit issued in Guangzhou City for one year, and shall meet one of the following two conditions: 1. Live legally and stably in Haizhu District; 2. Work (or start up businesses) legally in Haizhu District.

Their children shall meet the following conditions.

Children who apply for point-based admission as first-year students in primary schools shall be at least 6 years old and have not yet entered schools. Children who apply for point-based admission as first-year students in junior high schools shall be fresh graduates of primary schools in the current year. The school-age children or adolescents who need to postpone their admission due to their physical conditions shall obtain approval from the education authority of the county where their registered residences are located or the people’s government of the local town.

Article 5 The term “legal and stable residence” herein refers to meeting one of the following conditions:

(1) Owning property housing in Haizhu District.

(2) The legal rental of housing in Haizhu District has been registered in the sub-district migrant and rental housing service management authority.

Article 6 The application process for point-based admission is as follows:

(1) Confirmation of points: Before applying for point-based admission for children who move with them in Haizhu District in the current year, applicants shall confirm the points of “point-based admission” in “Point-based Service Management Information System for Migrant Workers in Guangzhou” (<https://djf.lsj.gz.gov.cn/bjpublic/login>).

(2) Online registration: Applicants log in to the designated website at the time specified in the Detailed Rules of the current year to apply for point-based admission. Overdue registration will not be accepted.

(3) Preliminary examination of documents: Applicants who have passed the online preliminary examination shall prepare the application documents and submit the documents to the designated acceptance site of point-based admission for preliminary examination and acceptance within the specified time. Failure to submit paper documents within the time limit shall be deemed as giving up the application.

(4) Reexamination of documents and announcement of results: Each acceptance site of point-based admission shall submit the preliminary examination results to Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau, which shall send the documents to relevant government sectors for reexamine ex officio and then summarize them for announcement to the public. The announcement time shall not be less than 5 natural days.

Applicants who disagree on their announced points can report the situation in writing to Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau during the announcement period, and Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau will handle the objection within 5 working days and give a written reply. After the objection is handled, the list of qualified applicants will be announced to the public.

(5) Filling in intentions: Haizhu District Education Bureau will announce the enrollment plan to the public according to the admission vacancy and the applications for point-based admission of the year. Applicants will fill in intentions for their children who have obtained the point-based admission qualifications through the designated website within the specified time. Failure to fill in intentions as required or failure to confirm after filling in intentions will be deemed as giving up the point-based admission qualifications.

(6) Arranging admission qualifications: Haizhu District Education Bureau allocates admission qualifications through the computer system according to the principles of “giving priority to points, considering intentions and making overall arrangements”. For the applicants who have the same points, the admission qualification will be granted according to the positive order of the scores of index names of *Point-based Service Management Index System and Score Table for Migrant Workers in Guangzhou Municipality*. If, according to the above rules, an applicant’s child is not admitted to the target school, the system will automatically coordinate one that is not full on the premise that the applicant agrees on the coordinated arrangements; applicants who do not agree on the coordinated arrangements shall not be admitted.

(7) Admission qualification confirmation: The applicant confirms the admission results within the specified time, and failure to confirm within the time limit shall be deemed as giving up the point-based admission qualification for the children of migrant workers.

(8) Registration: The children of migrant workers who have obtained the point-based admission qualification shall bring the admission documents to the admission school for registration at the specified time. Failure to report to the admission school within the time limit shall be deemed as automatic abandonment of the admission.

(9) Migrant workers who do not hand in the points application, give up the point-based admission qualification or fail to meet the point-based admission conditions can apply for admission qualifications in legally established private schools according to the enrollment policy of the current year.

Article 7 Fees and student status management

For the privately-run schools that grant point-based admission qualifications to children of migrant workers, the services for the purchase of admission qualifications shall be implemented by the Finance Bureau according to the superior-level policy standards. If the charging standard of a privately-run compulsory education school where the students are enrolled is equal to or lower than the financial subsidy standard, the said services shall be charged according to the school's charging standard; if the charging standard of a privately-run compulsory education school where the students are enrolled is higher than the financial subsidy standard, the difference shall be paid by the parents. For the public schools that grant point-based admission qualifications to children of migrant workers, project subsidies shall be provided by the Finance Bureau for the purpose of improving their basic facilities. All public and privately-run schools shall avoid charging fees other than those stipulated by the competent pricing authority.

Children of migrant workers enrolled through the point-based admission system will no longer retain the point-based admission qualification in Haizhu District if they transfer to other schools or relocate household registration to Guangzhou during their primary or junior high school. They shall re-apply for point-based admission for entering junior middle school from primary school

Article 8 Haizhu District Education Bureau and Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau shall take the lead in guiding the point-based admission of the children of migrant workers in Haizhu District. The relevant government sectors of the district shall clarify their responsibilities, strengthen communication, cooperate closely and make concerted efforts to ensure that the children of migrant workers can apply for admission qualifications according to this Plan smoothly.

Haizhu District Migrant Service Bureau is responsible for coordinating and guiding each acceptance site to carry out the registration and acceptance of the point-based admission for children of migrant workers, reviewing the preliminary examination results of each acceptance site, handling publicity and objections, submitting the point-based admission list to Haizhu District Education Bureau, and cooperating with Haizhu District Education Bureau to allocate admission qualifications.

Haizhu District Education Bureau is responsible for developing and publishing the enrollment schools and enrollment plans for the children of migrant workers in the compulsory education stage within its jurisdiction, and making overall arrangements for admission qualifications based on the scores and intentions of the migrant workers.

The Publicity Department of the Haizhu District Party Committee is responsible for coordinating various publicity channels such as portal websites and WeChat official account, and advocating government policy to enterprises and migrant workers.

The Office of the Institutional Organization Commission of the Haizhu District Party Committee is responsible for the staffing of public primary and secondary schools in Haizhu District according to the number of students in public primary and secondary schools (including the number of children who are studying in Guangzhou).

The Haizhu District Development and Reform Bureau is responsible for incorporating the compulsory education for the children of migrant workers in Haizhu District into the economic and social development plan and the annual plan, and incorporating the construction of relevant schools into the fixed assets investment plan and the annual plan.

The Haizhu District Finance Bureau is responsible for giving financial subsidies to the public and private schools that have the task of admitting the children of migrant workers as arranged by Haizhu District Education Bureau.

The Haizhu District Human Resources and Social Security Bureau is responsible for reviewing the social insurance information and other documents of migrant workers.

The Haizhu District Housing and Urban-Rural Development Bureau is responsible for reviewing the housing lease filing documents.

The Haizhu District Market Regulation Bureau is responsible for reviewing the business situation of the migrant workers in Haizhu District.

The Haizhu District Public Security Sub-bureau is responsible for reviewing the household registration of migrant workers; assisting the education authority to maintain the enrollment order and

ensure the safety around schools.

Haizhu Branch of the Guangzhou Municipal Planning and Natural Resources Bureau is responsible for reviewing legal and stable residence documents, such as property right certificates.

Haizhu Sub-center of the Guangzhou Municipal Medical Insurance Center is responsible for reviewing the medical insurance information of migrant workers.

The relevant sub-district offices are responsible for accepting the applications for point-based admission of migrant workers and conducting pre-examination and preliminary examination.

Article 9 Migrant workers shall ensure that the relevant information provided by them is true and valid. If there is any fraud, once verified, their application qualifications and corresponding subsidies and allowances will be immediately canceled, and they will be investigated for legal responsibilities according to laws.

The relevant authorities shall investigate and affix the responsibility for the abuse of power, dereliction of duty and fraud in the enrollment of the children of migrant workers.

Article 10 This Plan shall not be applicable to the children of migrant workers who meet the conditions to be included into the List of Policy-prioritized Students in Compulsory Education Stage in Guangzhou Municipality and are entitled to compulsory education admission qualifications according to the relevant enrollment regulations of primary and secondary schools in Guangzhou Municipality and Haizhu District in the current year.

Article 11 This Plan shall come into force on the date of release and shall be valid for five years. *The Notice of Haizhu District People's Government of Guangzhou Municipality on the Release of the Implementation Plan of Point-based Admission for Children of Migrant Workers in Haizhu District* (Hai Fu Gui [2022] No. 1) shall be abolished accordingly. During the implementation period, if there is a new situation or if the superior authorities issue a new policy on compulsory education for children of migrant workers, this Plan shall be adjusted on the basis of the actual conditions of Haizhu District.
